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PLATINUM-GROUP METALS IN OCTOBER 2012

Engelhard's average October prices for platinum and rhodium increased slightly and that for palladium decreased by 4% compared with average September prices. The average monthly iridium and ruthenium prices remained unchanged during the same period. Platinum and palladium prices decreased from the beginning to the end of the month. The continued unrest in the South African platinum mining industry led to supply disruptions, which supported prices early in the month. Global economic conditions exerted downward price pressures for the remainder of the month. Platinum prices remained below those for gold and higher than those for rhodium.

Stillwater Mining Co. (Billings, MT) produced 3,950 kilograms (kg) of palladium and platinum during the third quarter of 2012, which was 5% less than production during the second quarter of 2012, and a slight decrease compared with production during the third quarter of 2011. Production from the Stillwater Mine was 2,900 kg of palladium and platinum during the third quarter 2012, which was 4% less than production during the second quarter of 2012 and slightly less than 2011 third quarter production. The East Boulder Mine produced 1,020 kg of palladium and platinum, which was 7% less than production during the second quarter of 2012 and slightly less than production in the third quarter of 2011. Stillwater's production guidance for 2012 remained at 15,600 kg of palladium and platinum. About 3,000 kg of palladium, platinum, and rhodium was recovered from recycled autocatalysts during the third quarter of 2012, which was a 22% decrease compared with recycling volumes in the second quarter of 2012. Progress continued on the Blitz and Graham Creek development projects, adjacent to the Stillwater and East Boulder Mines, respectively. The tunnel boring machine, which had been assembled during the past 4 months, was operational at the Blitz project. The Blitz project was expected to be in development for the next 5 years, and remained on track for completion in 2017. The Graham Creek project was progressing ahead of plan. The tunnel boring machine at the Graham Creek project advanced a total of about 1,700 meters (m) since early in 2011, which was 70% of the planned total 2,500 m of new mine access. No estimate was given for the anticipated increase in production (Stillwater Mining Co., 2012).

Workers' strikes continued at platinum mines in South Africa. Strikes at Anglo American Platinum Ltd.'s (Johannesburg, South Africa) (Amplats) Rustenburg mines, which began in September, spread to Amplats' Amandelbult and Union operations in early October. Amplats fired 12,000 workers for the strike action. Amplats made reinstatement offers, but workers remained on strike beyond monthend. Lost production as a result of the strikes totaled 4,300 kg of platinum, and Amplats lowered its range of production guidance for 2012 to 68,000 to 75,000 kg of platinum from 75,000 to 78,000 kg of platinum. Workers at Atlatsa Resources Corp.'s (Sandton, South Africa) Bokoni Mine also went on strike. Atlatsa fired more than 2,000 employees for the strike action and gave the workers until October 10 to appeal their dismissal and return. Workers reported widespread intimidation of those attempting to return to work, and the deadline for reinstatement was extended beyond monthend (Johnson Matthey plc, 2012a, b).

OJSC MMC Norilsk Nickel (Moscow, Russia) produced 21,800 kg of palladium and 5,440 kg of platinum during the third quarter, which were 4% and 6% less, respectively, than second quarter production. The decreased production was mainly from Norilsk's Russian division owing to higher than projected second quarter production (OJSC MMC Norilsk, 2012).
